Listen to a conversation between Hugo and Charlotte about what it means to be an artist.

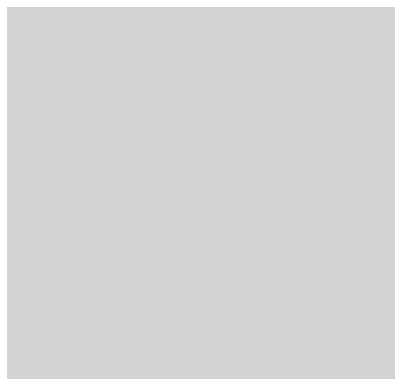
Refer to the passage in your answer to Question One on page 3.
