Candidates will be required to answer three questions. All questions will relate to the specified context below. Questions may require candidates to refer to provided resources. An in-depth understanding of the psychology related to the specified context is expected.

Questions will examine the candidates' ability to:

- Critique research methods in the specified context
- Develop solutions to a given issue using psychological approaches, within the specified context
- Critique debates that are prevalent within the specified context.
