Instructions and questions will be in both te reo Māori and English but candidates will be required to write all their answers in te reo Māori.

Candidates will be required to write ONE piece of writing of at least 400 words in te reo Māori. Topics will cover local, national, and global themes across different text types.

Assessment materials in the examination are provided to support 'Te whakapuaki whakaaro hei tuhinga whakamōhio, te pānui kia mōhio ki te reo o tōna ao.

Conditions of the External Assessment

The TAPā must be managed by the Exam Centre Manager. Candidates completing this TAPā must observe all [NCEA - Assessment and Examination Rules and Procedures](#). During the assessment the candidate may only use the resources provided for the task.

No written material or other resources may be taken into the examination room. The candidate must complete the TAPā within the allotted time of three hours.
