Te Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPā)

He Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPā) tēnei, ka whakaritea, ka mākahia hoki e Te Mana Tohu Mātauranga o Aotearoa (NZQA). Ka whakahaerehia tēnei TAPā e ngā Kaiwhakahaere Whakamātautau puta noa i ngā kura kua whakaaetia hei wāhi whakamātautau.

Ahako he TAPā tēnei aromatawai ā-waho, me ū ki ngā ture katoa o te whakamātautau ā-waho. Ka tuku atu Te Mana Tohu Mātauranga o Aotearoa i ngā puka whakamātautau ki te pokapū o te wāhi tū ai te whakamātautau.

Ka tīmata te TAPā a te ahiahi. Nā, ahako he toru hāora te roa o tēnei TAPā, tērā pea ka oti ki roto i te iwa tekau meneti.

He wāhanga mātakitaki kiriata tō tēnei TAPā, ā, me mau ngā ākonga e mahi ana i tēnei TAPā ā-matihiko i ētahi pokitaringa.

Te Whakatakotoranga Aromatawai ā-Waho

E rua ngā wāhanga kei roto i tēnei aromatawai ā-waho.

Te Wāhanga Tuatahi: He mātaki kiriata/He whakautu pātai.

Ko tā te ākonga mahi he mātaki i tētahi kiriata e whakatairanga ana i tētahi mātāpono o te reo Māori, arā, te 'A' me te 'O', kātahi ka whakautu pātai ki tētahi pouaka patopato.

Ko ētahi o ngā pātai ka hāngai ki te whakamahinga o te A me te O ki te horopaki, ā, ko ētahi pātai ka hāngai ki ngā pukenga pānui aroā. Kei te ākonga te tikanga mehemea ka whakautu ki te reo Māori, ki te reo Pākehā rānei.

Te Wāhanga Tuarua: He pānuitanga/He whakautu pātai.

Ko tā te ākonga mahi he pānui i tētahi kōwae e whakamahi ana i tētahi mātāpono o te reo Māori, arā, te 'A' me te 'O', kātahi ka whakautu pātai. Pērā i te wāhanga tuatahi o te TAPā, kei te ākonga te tikanga mehemea ka patopatohia ngā whakautu ki te reo Māori, ki te reo Pākehā rānei.

Ngā Kaupapa Matua

Ka ū tonu ki te 'A' me te 'O' i tēnei tau. Ka tāpirihia ētahi pātai e kitea ai te māramatanga ki te horopaki mā te aroā.

Ngā Herenga Aromatawai ā-waho

Me tutuki tēnei whakamātautau ki mua i te aroaro o te Kaiwhakahaere Whakamātautau, ki te wāhi tū ai ngā whakamātautau ā-waho, ā, me whai i ngā ture whakamātautau anō hoki.

The Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPā)

This Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPā), or Common Assessment Activity (CAA), is developed and marked by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA).

This TAPā will be administered by the Exam Centre Manager. Though the mode of assessment is a TAPā, the end of year examination rules apply. NZQA will prepare and deliver booklets for this TAPā to the appropriate exam centres.

There is a section in this TAPā where candidates must watch a video. Candidates completing this TAPā digitally must use headphones.

External Assessment Specifications

This TAPā has TWO sections.

Section One: Short video and questions

The candidate will watch a short video up to three times highlighting an essential principle of the Māori language, such as the 'A' and 'O' categories. The candidate will then answer questions pertaining to the video. In addition to candidates showing their ability to apply the language principle in a familiar context, there will be questions that demonstrate comprehension. The candidate may choose to respond in English or te reo Māori.

Section Two: Written text with questions

The candidate will read a short passage focusing on an essential principle of the Māori language, such as the 'A' and 'O' categories. The candidate will then answer questions pertaining to the text. The candidate may choose to respond in English or te reo Māori.

Key Focus of the External Assessment

In 2026, the 'A' and 'O' categories will remain the focus for the TAPā

Conditions of the External Assessment

The TAPā must be managed by the Exam Centre Manager. Candidates completing this TAPā must observe all [NCEA - Assessment and Examination Rules and Procedures](#). During the assessment the candidate may only use the resources provided for the task.

No written material or other resources may be taken into the examination room. The candidate must complete the TAPā within the allotted time of three hours.

The candidate may choose to respond in English or te reo Māori.
