Applications for delivery in 2027	To help with your planning and processes for internal quality assurance, below are the recommended dates for submitting applications for programmes of study you want to deliver in 2027. Level 7 Diplomas Talk to your Approvals and Accreditation (A&A) contact for guidance before developing a new or revising an existing Level 7 Diploma. Programmes and micro-credentials at Levels 1 to 6 You can submit applications at any time. If you intend to be ready for delivery in Semester One 2027, we recommend you apply to us before 2 October 2026 for: • new approval and accreditation for programmes at levels 1 to 6, or changes (Type 2) to existing programmes at levels 1 to 6 • new listing, approval and accreditation for micro-credentials, or changes to existing micro-credentials at levels 1 to 6 • accreditation to provide existing programmes or micro-credentials at levels 1 to 6 • changes to existing Programme (Transitional) Call or email your A&A contact if you need more information, or e-mail Approvals_Accreditation@nzqa.govt.nz	As needed: dates below Level 7 Diplomas: Talk to your A&A contact Level 1-6 programmes and micro-credentials (including changes to them): 2 October 2026

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TEO self review – check your organisation’s education sector log on TEO self review information	For TEOs undertaking self review from July 2026 Schedule for TEO self-review TEOs must use their education sector log on (ESL) to access the portal. ESLs are managed by the Ministry of Education. We encourage TEOs to check that they have access to the NZQA provider portal using their ESL. Check with your organisation’s delegated authoriser if you need ESL user access or contact the Education Service Desk at service.desk@education.govt.nz.	Anytime prior to starting your self review

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Fit and Proper Person and Conflict of Interest declarations Submit a new or amended declaration: - before any new governing member starts - if an existing governing member has a new or changed conflict of interest - if an existing governing member has a change in their fit and proper person status See Section 10 of the Education and Training Act 2020(external link) for the definition of governing member	PTEs only: - applying for registration - registered PTEs	As needed
